In Fiscal Year 2022, your donations and dues helped pay for nearly

\$900,000

in programming expenses that supported the Stuyvesant community!



About \$275,000 toward class reunions, in-person events, communications, and programming that brought the Stuyvesant community - students and alumni - together



Almost \$155,000 went toward funding needs of the School's technology, science, social studies, arts, and guidance departments



Almost \$20,000 to sponsor the PSAT for all Stuyvesant juniors and sophomores, enabling Stuyvesant to have the highest number of National Merit Semifinalists in the country for the THIRD year in a row



Over \$100,000 went to diversity initiatives like *StuyPrep*, which provides underpriveleged students with free tutoring, increased accessed, and connection to Stuyvesant



About \$150,000 in support of scholarships that help graduating seniors defray the rising cost of higher education
